






At Home






If I have my own space at home, this is what it looks like








Who I Live With

Discuss the visitors to the house in detail.


Talk about friends coming over or not in more detail.

Who would live with you in your dream home?






Add in further questions about the dream home, where would it be (what area/country) what colour would it be etc?

My Bedroom






Children can draw or talk about their room.
